Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Prepare and paint aluminum louvers, sunshades, and other architectural products in a production environment.
- Knowledge of all phases of powder coat painting from materials preparation to finish paint.
- Perform adhesion tests and apply wet primer.
- Experience changing colors several times per day.
- Follow all safety regulations including keeping the work area clean and in orderly condition as well as wearing all appropriate safety attire for the job that is being performed.
- Observe machine gauges and equipment operation to detect defects or deviations from standards, and make adjustments.
- Determine paint flow, viscosity, and coating quality by performing visual inspections.
- Weigh or measure chemicals, coatings, or paints before adding them to machines.
- Select appropriate coatings, paints, or sprays in order to complete pieces.
- Set up and operate machines to paint or coat products with such materials as paint or rustproofing materials.
- Record operational data on specified forms.
- Operate auxiliary machines or equipment used in coating or painting processes.

Education / Experience Requirement

- High School Diploma or GED
- Minimum 2 years' experience painting aluminum materials.
