Essential Duties and Responsibilities

1. Sets up and operates various press brake, shear, and other fabrication equipment in accordance with established procedures and guidelines.

- 2. Calculates required tonnage using various punches and dies.
- 3. Adheres to and follows SPC charts and cut sheets.
- 4. Reads and interprets blueprints and diagrams.
- 5. Adjusts machine settings to complete tasks accurately, according to specifications, and in a timely fashion.
- 6. Performs daily PM's on equipment.

Education / Experience Requirement

- 2. Must be experience and have competent understanding of industrial PC-based controller with Windows operating system with CAD function.
